NOTICE OF HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Oklahoma Cotton Council (“Applicant”) has filed an Application with the Oklahoma Corporation Commission (“the Commission”) for an Order Modifying Commission Order No.199421 and Authorizing an Increase in Rates cotton gins operating in Oklahoma may charge for the Ginning of Cotton to \$2.75/cwt (currently \$2.00/cwt), and an Increase in Rates cotton gins operating in Oklahoma may charge for the Bagging and Tying of Cotton to \$10.00/bale (currently \$7.50/bale). Applicant seeks to have the requested Order in effect as of July 31, 2026.
